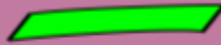

## Math

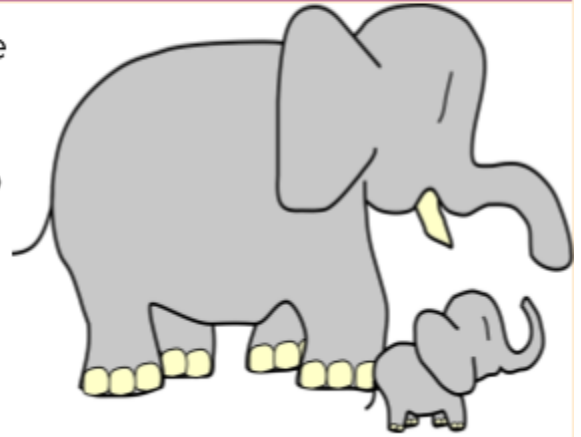

Please continue to talk to your students about the Math they are working on. They will get new books on Monday that should come back and forth.



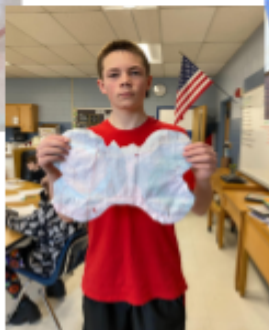
## Family & Consumer Sciences
