At 6:02 p.m., Mark Lane called the Hampton Falls Public Hearing to **order**.

The purpose of the Public Hearing is for the withdrawal of \$45,000 from the Special Education Expendable Trust Fund for unanticipated professional services. The current deficit in professional services account is (-\$57,992).

This meeting was properly posted - a legal notice was published in the Hampton Union on May 25, 2018.

The Special Education Trust Fund Balance is \$157,517 with a note that the 2018 warrant approved the transfer of \$25,000 from this year's unreserved fund balance to the special education trust, if available.
