

ANNUAL GOALS, OBJECTIVES, AND REVIEW SEQUENCE

Each year the Board will formulate goals and objectives. The goals and objectives may include, but are not limited to, the board functions of visions, structure, accountability, and advocacy.

At the conclusion of the school year the board shall reflect on the degree to which the goals and objectives have been accomplished by conducting a board self-evaluation and engaging in board development activities where needed.

It shall be the policy of the Winnacunnet School Board to disseminate its goals for each school year following the guideline sequence below:

- May -** Winnacunnet School Board formulates the next school year's goals.
- May -** Joint Board, Superintendent, Principal, and Winnacunnet High School faculty receive a copy of preliminary goals.
- July -** Superintendent and Principal submit their goals for School Board discussion and adoption.

July-June WHS goals appear on each monthly agenda for discussion and action.

Annual Goals

1. To concentrate the Board's collective effort on its policy making and planning responsibilities.
2. To formulate Board policies which best serve the educational interests of each student.
3. To provide the Superintendent with sufficient and adequate guidelines for implementing Board policies.
4. To maintain effective communications with the public the Board serves and with staff and students in order to maintain awareness of attitudes, opinions, desires, and ideas.
5. To conduct Board business openly, soliciting and encouraging broad-based involvement in the Board's decision-making processes by public, students, and staff.
