BUS SAFETY RULES: As October is National Bus Safety month, it's a good time to review bus rules. Please take a few minutes to review these procedures with your child to assist our drivers with your son or daughter's safety:

- Stay in seat, no moving once the bus has started the route.*
- No food is allowed to be eaten on the bus, only water is allowed.*
- No legs, backpacks and other items are allowed in the aisles.*
- Keep head, hands, feet, etc. inside the bus.*
- No swearing, obscene gestures, or any acts of physical aggression.*
- Windows are not to be open more than halfway.*
- No physical contact with other students.*
- Speak with an indoor voice.*
- If using an electronic device, you must not share and must use earbuds with one left out, to be able to hear any bus driver instructions.*
