

Boston Harbor Cruise Permission Form



On Thursday, May 17, 2018 Seabrook Middle School 8th graders will have the opportunity to cruise Boston Harbor on the Spirit of Boston. Students will enjoy an evening aboard an amazing ship, while they consume an elegant buffet meal, dance and see Boston's beautiful skyline at night. We will be sailing as far South as Castle Island and as far North as the Mystic River. In case of inclement weather the event will take place dockside.

8th grade students who will be attending the trip will be expected to be at the school no later than 4:00 PM for attendance checking and picture taking. The bus will be departing Seabrook Middle School at 4:30 PM sharp! We will be boarding the Spirit of Boston at 6:00 PM and will cruise Boston Harbor until 10:00 PM. We will be returning to Seabrook Middle School at approximately 11:00 PM. At that time, parents may check the students out and bring them home.

The trip cost is \$85 per person, the price includes all expenses including; a buffet dinner, dance, cruise and photograph. The meal is an all you can eat buffet, dessert and unlimited beverages. For more information as to what specifically will be on the menu, log on to www.spiritofboston.com. A professional photographer will be aboard the ship taking pictures of the students as they board. The students will receive a complimentary picture as a parting gift.

In order to reserve space on the trip, we are asking that an initial deposit of \$25 be brought in to the middle school office by January 15, 2018. The remainder of the balance will be due on February 5, 2018.

ATTIRE

The atmosphere aboard the boat is elegant and classy. Students are expected to wear appropriate clothing to reflect the atmosphere. Young men should be dressed in slacks, a button down shirt and a tie. Young ladies are expected to wear dresses or nice dress pants with an appropriate shirt.

CLOTHING NOT PERMITTED: jeans, sneakers, t-shirts, sweatshirts or anything ripped. Students who show up for the cruise that are not dressed appropriately will be sent home and not permitted to attend the cruise.

TRANSPORTATION

Students will need transportation to the school on the afternoon of the trip and will need to be picked up from the school when the bus returns. If a ride home will be with someone other than a parent or

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guardian the student must have a pre-approved note. Notes will be accepted up to two days prior to the trip at the latest.

STUDENT BEHAVIOR MATRIX

Students are required to behave respectfully on the trip, all school rules apply. Participation in this trip is a privilege, not a right. A student may NOT be allowed to participate in this trip if he or she is serving a school suspension, expulsion or other form of exclusion from school due to violations of the Seabrook Middle School Student Handbook, Seabrook School Board Policies and/or school-based rules at the time of the trip. Additionally, a student's overall behavior performance throughout the year may be taken into consideration in order to ensure the health, safety and welfare of other students participating in the trip. Students and parents will be notified two weeks prior to the trip of their standing. It should be noted, however, that revocation of the trip privilege can occur up until the departure of the trip. Students who are not allowed to attend the trip should NOT expect a refund for the cost of the trip.
