Dear Parents and Guardians,


The Seabrook School District encourages parents/guardians and community members to volunteer at our schools, helping enrich the lives of our students and connect them to the community of support around them. As with every opportunity we provide our students, we want to ensure that student and staff safety is at the forefront. Therefore, from this point forward, we are requiring that all designated volunteers complete a criminal background check.


This safety measure is aligned with the law recently passed by the New Hampshire State Legislature, School Employee and Designated School Volunteer Criminal History Records Check (RSA 189:13-a). Based on this law, we are requiring all those who volunteer within the Seabrook School District to complete a background check through the SAU 21 office prior to volunteering. This includes those who wish to attend a field trip, help in a classroom, assist in the office, help facilitate a classroom activity/celebration, assist in events (ex. Reading Carnival and Field Day). Therefore, if you plan on volunteering in any way within our school district while your child is enrolled, we recommend that you contact the SAU 21 office to complete the background check.

The process takes approximately 30 days from the time of your appointment. Even if you are not sure at this point if you would like to volunteer, you may want to complete this process, so that you are cleared to volunteer, as we wouldn't want you to miss out on an opportunity, such as a field trip with our students.
